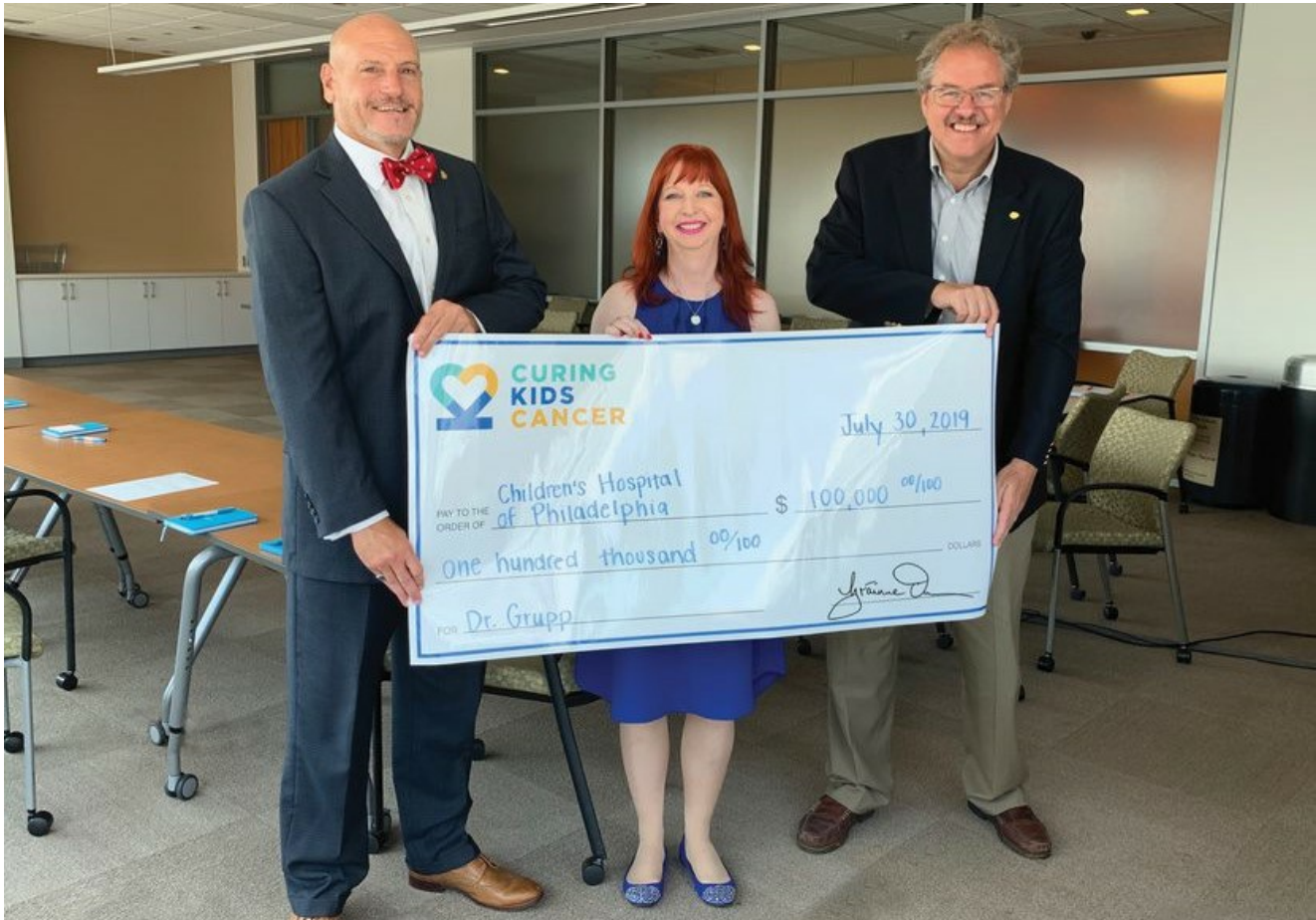


Malvern Bank Supports Nonprofit That Funds Research to Find Cures for Childhood Cancer
